If your child is using the shuttle bus, please drop them off 10 minutes before departure and pick them up on time to keep our schedule running smoothly.

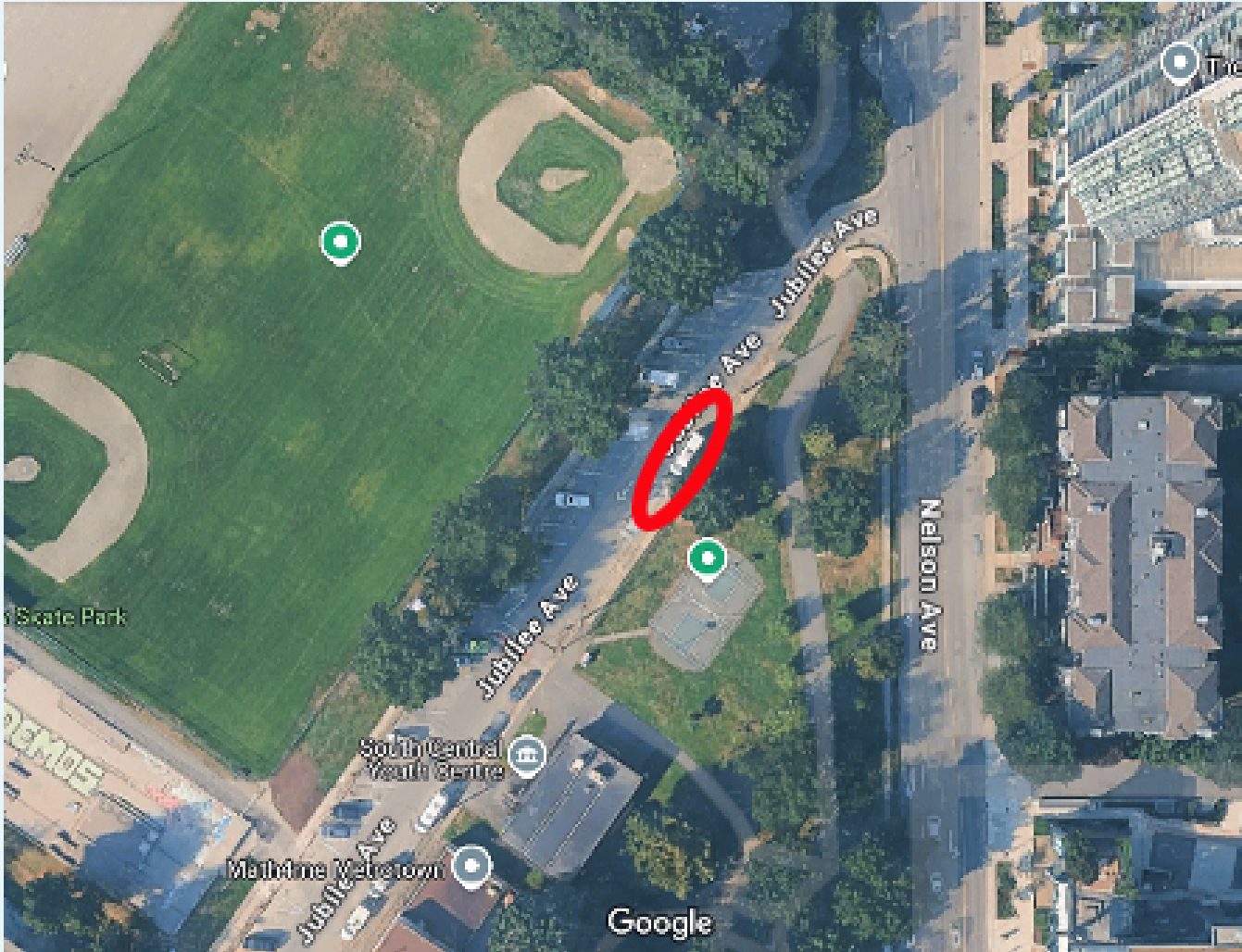
