



CHANGE OF LOCATION FOR GILMORE AVENUE STOP

Dear Parents,

For the duration of our Week 9 camp - August 24-28 - there is construction work being carried out on Gilmore Avenue, and a road closure on Gilmore Avenue between William Street and 1st Avenue. Therefore the pick-up & drop-off location for the Gilmore Avenue bus participants will change for the duration of the camp next week. Please find updated information below (please note that if you receive the standard automated pre-camp email reminder on Saturday morning, please disregard this and use this email information instead).

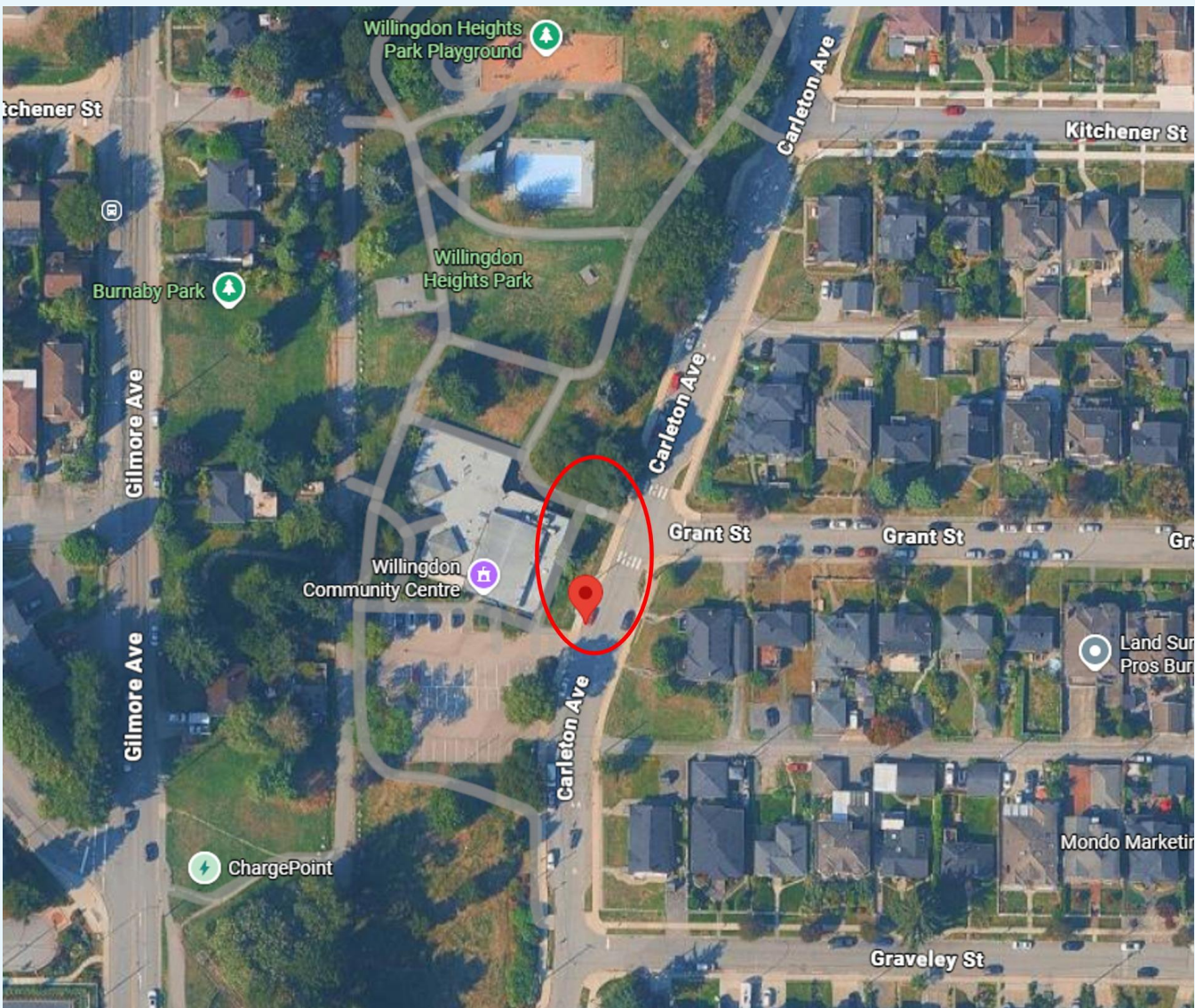
If your child is using the shuttle bus, please drop them off 10 minutes before departure and pick them up on time to keep our schedule running smoothly. Please allow extra time due to the Gilmore Avenue road closure.

BURNABY SHUTTLE - CARLETON AVENUE (INSTEAD OF GILMORE AVENUE)

The bus will depart from Carleton Avenue outside Willingdon Community Centre. The bus may be required to stop anywhere along Carleton Avenue alongside the park, so look out for a small white bus with Mt Seymour branding. This location is a short distance from the original advertised location.

SIGN IN / OUT PROCEDURE

All children will be checked in upon arrival at the bus stop or at Mt Seymour.

To ensure the safety of all children in our care, the adult assigned to pick up a child must confirm a **security code** before the child can be released. This security code is the **last 4 digits of the phone number** of the **primary parent/guardian** listed on the child's Mt Seymour account.

If you are not the primary parent/guardian collecting the child, please come prepared to provide the last 4 digits of the parent/guardian phone number of the child. Our bus supervisors will be able to prompt you with the name of the primary parent/guardian listed if required.

For guests driving up the mountain, the same procedure applies at pick-up.

Please also note that a **\$25 late fee** may be applied for any **significant late pick-ups**.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep our programs safe and secure.
