Welcome and thank you for your interest in the Mt Seymour Development Team for the 2020/2021 winter season! The vision of the team is to develop and support skiers and snowboarders 15-23 years of age to reach an amateur and/or professional athletic level.

Benefits

Mt Seymour will endeavour to assist in the development of team riders and showcase members to the public, media and our industry partners. Benefits include:

- Team member profiles, photos and video segments posted and promoted on Mt Seymour's website, e-newsletter, blog and social media platforms.
- Photography and video sessions
- Paid entry to events hosted by Mt Seymour.

As a member of the team you are entitled to one free Mt Seymour Industry Season Pass. The Industry Season Pass gives you access to the lifts for the 2020/2021 season, as well as a 10% discount at The Rock Chute Inn and Grill Works when you show your Industry Pass.

Application Process

All potential members of the team will be required to submit an application to Mt Seymour. We will evaluate each application based on the following:

Detailed Cover Letter, Resume & Portfolio outlining:

- Personal contact information
- Your professional athletic career aspirations ****this is important – please be detailed****
- A detailed list of previous **sanctioned** contests and results from the 2019/2020 season. Participation in Park Jams do not count unfortunately.
- Hi resolution photos
- Video edits – include a minimum of two edits that showcase your style and highlight your strengths as a rider or skier
- Past & present sponsorships (if any)
- Community work on the mountain such as helping in the terrain parks, volunteering at events, or donating time to our freestyle ski and snowboard camps
- Industry references

Competition Agreement

As a member of the Development Team, you are required to enter and compete in **a minimum of two official slopestyle events in British Columbia if they are not cancelled due to COVID-19**. This requirement must be fulfilled by April, 2021, and will determine your spot for the following

season. Competition scores will be reviewed and evaluated in November, 2021, for the following season.

Code of Conduct Agreement

If chosen, members of the Development Team represent Mt Seymour as one of our team riders and are expected to represent the resort at all times with a positive, respectful attitude. Each team rider is required to show the utmost respect to Mt Seymour staff, volunteers and guests. You agree to refrain from being intoxicated while riding and from using threatening, abusive or disrespectful language and behaviour. Team members eating in our F&B outlets need to show respect at all times and not request free food or drink at any time.

You agree to obey the Alpine Responsibility Code at all times and only enter the backcountry via the designated gates. You agree not to bring any snowboards or skis into the buildings.

Every member of the team must adhere to this code of conduct and agrees that if they fail to abide by the code they risk losing their spot on the team.

Members of the Development Team are representatives of Mt Seymour and are required to display respectful and responsible behaviour at the resort at all times.
