## **2020-2021 School Ski & Snowboard Lessons Terms & Conditions**

### Booking

- A minimum of 20 participants is required for school rates. A minimum of 3 participants per ability level and sport is required. One free supervisor lift/rental for every 6 paid participants.
- Schools must book a minimum of 3 weeks in advance. Dates and times book up quickly so reserve early to get your preferred dates and times.
- A completed, signed reservation form is required to make a reservation, including the number of participants
- On-line registration will be closed 3 weeks prior to your visit to allow for scheduling of your school's instructors. Students who are ill on the day of lessons will be refunded. Students who miss a day(s) for reasons other than illness, will have a lift ticket(s) remaining on their lesson tag, for the current season. There are no make-up rentals or lessons.

### Free Grades 4-8 Season Passes and Corporate Passes

- Grade 4-8 Season Pass: One per child per season. Must be used within the season issued. Only available with four-day lesson program. Grade 4-8 Season Pass will be automatically added to the participant account at the same time of school program purchase. If the program is purchased prior to the start of the season, the pass will be mailed out to the purchaser address, OR if the pass holder already has a 2019/2020 season pass, their pass will be reloaded, and the guest can go straight to the lift once the mountain opens. If the 4-day school program is refunded, the Grade 4-8 Season Pass will be voided.
- Each corporate pass can be exchanged for one lift ticket per day. Must be used within the season issued. We no longer offer the Corporate Pass List option. Max one or two corporate passes per school.

### Changes/Cancellations

- Adults and students showing any symptoms of COVID-19 are expected to isolate at home and seek medical advice.
- If the school or mountain is closed due to COVID-19, families will be refunded by Mt Seymour. If the mountain is closed due to inclement weather, we will re-schedule your visit, and if this cannot be arranged, families will be refunded.
- Changes are subject to instructor availability and must be made at least 3 weeks in advance

### Payment

- Payment is on-line by credit card. The e-commerce also accepts Visa debit, and Mt Seymour gift cards. Eligible refunds will be applied to the credit card(s) on file.

## Visit Preparation

- Please check our website [www.mtseymour.ca](http://www.mtseymour.ca) for daily weather and operational updates.
- Mt Seymour is an alpine environment, and as such, weather can change quickly. Unless Mt Seymour is closed for inclement weather, all programs run as usual (even in snow or rain).
- All vehicles must have winter tires and we recommend you carry chains. Please leave plenty of time to ascend the mountain.
- School organizers check in outside the Alpine Activity Centre 45 minutes prior to start time. Lesson tags will be given to the group organizer who is responsible for distributing them to the rest of the group participants. If you are late your activity will end as scheduled.
