2020-2021 School Snowshoe Terms and Conditions

Booking

- A minimum of 20 participants is required for school rates. One free chaperone is given for every 10 paying students. One free chaperone for every 5 paying students in Grades K-3. **Any additional parents/chaperones will not be accepted on the tour.**
- Schools must book at minimum 2 weeks in advance
- A completed, signed reservation form is required to make a reservation, including the number of participants
- On-line registration will be closed 2 weeks prior to visit to allow for scheduling your school's guides. Students who are ill on the day of the field trip will be refunded. Students who miss this day for reasons other than illness, will receive a one-day child trail/rental pass, valid for the current season. Student passes will be given to the main organizer on the day of.

Free Teacher/Organizer Passes

- The main organizer will receive 2 one-day trail/rental passes for each eligible chaperone (as above) on the day of the tour. Passes are valid for the current season.

Changes/Cancellations

- Adults and students showing any symptoms of COVID-19 are expected to isolate at home and seek medical advice.
- If the school or mountain is closed due to COVID-19, families will be refunded by Mt Seymour. If the mountain is closed due to inclement weather, we will re-schedule your visit, and if this cannot be arranged, families will be refunded.
- Changes are subject to guide availability and must be made at least 14 days in advance

Payment

- Payment is on-line by credit card. The e-commerce also accepts Visa debit, and Mt Seymour gift cards. Eligible refunds will be applied to the credit card(s) on file.

Visit Preparation

- Please check our website www.mtseymour.ca for daily weather and operational updates
- Mt Seymour is an alpine environment, and as such, weather can change quickly. Unless Mt Seymour is closed for inclement weather, all programs run as usual (even in snow or rain).
- All vehicles must have winter tires and we recommend you carry chains. Please leave plenty of time to ascend the mountain.

- School organizers check in at the Snowshoe Centre 30 minutes prior to start time. Tickets will be given to the group organizer who is responsible for distributing them to the rest of the group participants. If you are late your activity will end as scheduled.
